



HAVE YOU APPLIED FOR MEDICAID?

Has your income changed due to the COVID-19 pandemic?

Did you lose your health insurance coverage due to the COVID-19 pandemic?

You might qualify for Medicaid.

MAGI (Modified Adjusted Gross Income) Medicaid is generally available to individuals under 65 years of age who are not on Medicare and who meet household income eligibility requirements. Your household's gross income must be below 138% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. There is no resource limit.
